

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF O'CONNOR

POLICY FOR REMOVAL OF DEAD ANIMALS ON TOWNSHIP ROADS

PURPOSE: To establish the standards for removal of dead animals, both domestic and non domestic, found on Township roads.

RATIONAL: It is the responsibility of the Township to remove the carcass of a non-domestic animal that is found on a municipal road surface. Disposal of the carcass will be at the discretion of the Leadhand.

It is the responsibility of the owner of the domestic animal to dispose of the carcass.

POLICY STATEMENT: By-law number 97-05, as amended, states dogs shall not run at large. Dog/dogs that are killed on the Township roads are considered to be running at large.

If the owner of the animal will not remove the carcass from the roads, the Township road employees will dispose of it.

The disposal fee will be payable to the Township of O'Connor by the owner of the animal.

PAYMENT FOR DISPOSAL: If the Township is required to dispose of the carcass for any reason, a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee will be charged.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This policy shall come into effect as of September 9, 1999.
