



**Notice of Adoption of a New Official Plan**  
**The Corporation of the Township of O'Connor**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of O'Connor passed By-law Number 2018-09 on Monday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018, under Section 17 and 26 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P, 13, as amended, adopting a new Official Plan for the Township.

The purpose of By-law Number 2018-09 is to adopt a new Official Plan for the Township of O'Connor and to repeal the previous Official Plan, By-law Number 2001-03. A copy of the By-law and the new Official Plan may be viewed online at [www.oconnortownship.ca](http://www.oconnortownship.ca) or in person at the Township Office during regular business hours.

The new Official Plan will be submitted to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs for approval. The Minister of Municipal Affairs is the approval authority for the new Official Plan and may approve, modify and approve, or refuse to approve the new Official Plan. Any person or body is entitled to receive notice of the decision of the approval authority if a written request to be notified of the decision (including the person's or public body's address, fax number or email address) is made to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs at the following address:

**Purpose and Effect of the Official Plan**

The Official Plan sets out the Township's land use planning goals and policies that will guide the physical development and redevelopment of the Township, including the desired pattern of land uses and management of resources. Additionally, the Official Plan establishes the basis for actions related to use of land, and creates a framework for the implementation of the Township's powers and authority.

**Effect of Written and Oral Submissions**

Written and oral submissions relating to the Plan were considered by Township of O'Connor Council and where appropriate, the Plan was modified accordingly to further strengthen the draft policies.
