Summer Student Job – Roads Department Labourer

The Township of O'Connor is looking to hire two (2) Students for eight (8) weeks starting Monday, July 4, 2022 and working 35 hours per week.

Applicants for the position must:

- ⇒ be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period;
- ⇒ be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment; and,
- ⇒ have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

The summer students will be responsible for assisting the Road Department employees with their summer projects.

These projects could include cutting grass, cleaning up and painting of Township properties which include the recreation area, cemetery and disposal site; road, bridge and culvert repairs and maintenance; clearing any safety hazards on roadways and intersections; and possible minor construction work.

The main objective of the job is to provide a learning opportunity for students to gain hands-on experience learning new skills and more about their community, while emphasizing health and safety, responsibility, good work ethics and working as a team member alongside fellow co-workers.
