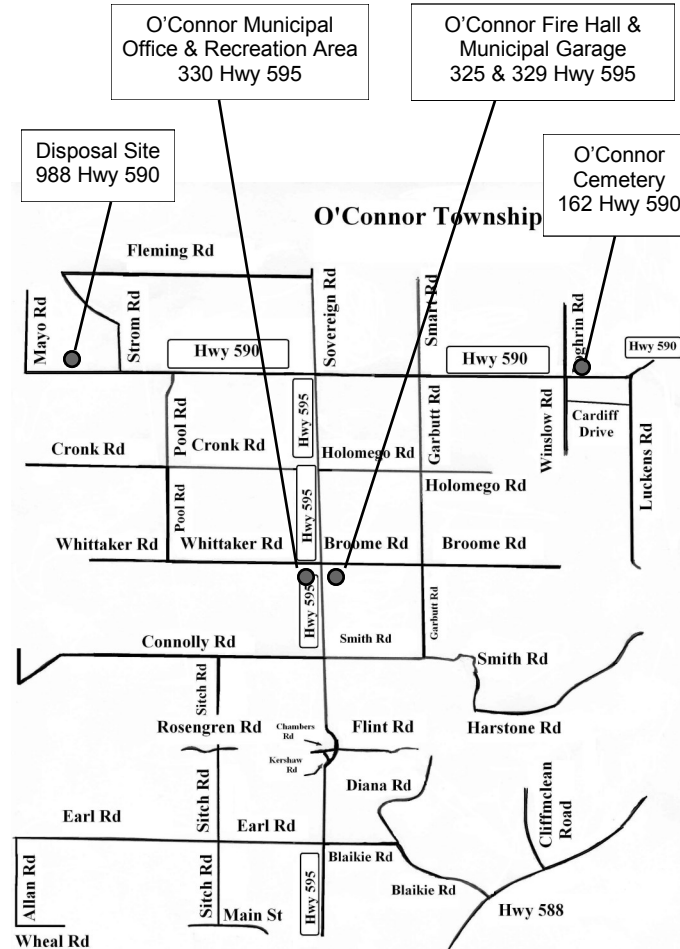

Disposal Site Recycling Depots



Please do your part to reduce the amount of material that is landfilled at this site by recycling when possible. This pamphlet outlines the various materials that are accepted for recycling. All recycling depots are clearly identified and if you are uncertain as to where you should be placing your items please ask the Disposal Site Caretaker for help.

Rules and Regulations:

- ◆ All users must be residents of the Township of O'Connor.
- ◆ Residents must have a Disposal Site Permit.
- ◆ Prohibited items include
 - Liquid Waste, e.g. waste oils flammables, paints, sewage
 - Animal carcasses
- ◆ Obey posted signs. Residents must deposit waste and recyclables in designated areas:
 - Burn Pile
 - brush, tree limbs, clean wood
 - No furniture
 - No windows
 - No shingles
 - No painted or varnished wood
 - No pressure treated wood
 - Upholstery & Furniture
 - Glass (no lids)
 - Scrap Metal
 - No wood or plastic
 - No Upholstery
 - No Electronics
 - Dry empty paint cans permitted
 - Electronics Only (Please carefully place items in the storage container provided.
 - Tires - No rims (Please place rims in Scrap Metal area)
 - Fridges, Freezers, Air Conditioners

These items will be charged \$20 for disposal to be paid at the Township of O'Connor Municipal Office during regular business hours prior to bringing to the Disposal Site. When disposing of refrigerated units at the O'Connor Disposal Site all doors must be removed from the units before placing them in the designated area and caretaker must be shown receipt of payment.

Recycling Bins

The recycling bins at the disposal site have two compartments. One compartment accepts pop cans plastic bottles, steel cans, milk cartons/tetra packs. The other compartment accepts paper and cardboard products.

Waste Electronics and Electrical Equipment (WEEE) are to be placed in the large shipping container located at the site. Items that can be placed in this area are computers, peripherals (mice, keyboards), monitors, printers and televisions, telephones, copiers, stereos, radios, MP3 players and other audio-visual equipment. This shipping container is pickup and transported for recycling. Please be careful when placing the items in the container to ensure that they are still intact when they reach there destination.

POP CANS

PLASTIC BOTTLES



Yes

- #1 plastics PET - pop bottles, water bottles
- #2 plastic PET - household cleaner bottles, e.g. shampoo dish soap

NO

- #3 - #7 plastics
- Shopping bags
- Plastic wrap
- Baggies
- Styrofoam
- Plastic tubs & lids
- Containers with hazardous wastes e.g. motor oil

MILK CARTONS/TETRA PAKS



Yes

- Milk cartons
- Juice boxes
- Tetra or gable top containers

- Waxed cardboard
